His main areas of Research interests include Malaria, Kala-azar and Intestinal coccidial Infections. He has developed New Diagnostic Techniques and Protocols which Include: (1) Fluorescent staining for speciation and quantitation of Malaria. (2) Fluorescent staining for Kala-azar, PKDL, and cutaneous leishmniasis, (3) Fluorescent staining for Filariasis. (4) techniques for Filarial worm from peripheral blood (5) Concentration and quantitation Diagnostic protocol for Kala-azar without bone marrow aspiration. (6) Fluorescent staining for Gonococcus. He has guided 31 PhD and MD students. He has published more than 80 papers in national and international journals including one text book; three monographs. He has been a fellow up Fogarty International, USA, and the World Health Organization. He has also served as consultants to WHO and International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) commission.
