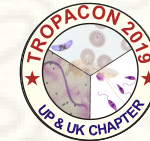

Instructions for Abstract submission

- Registration for the conference is mandatory for abstract submission.
- The abstract must be an unpublished original work which has not been presented at any previous conference.
- The abstract must be in English with Title - less than 20 words, Body - Maximum of 250 words (excluding title) of plain text without diagrams, charts, footnotes or references.
- Title must be in capital letters with font size 14. It should be short and concise.
- Abstract should be structured as follows: Title, Author, Introduction, Objectives, Methods, Results, and Conclusions.
- Identity of guide/institute should not be disclosed. Only name of presenter/author should be mentioned.
- The abstract must be typed using Times New Roman, font size 12 in MS Word format only.
- The abstract for oral/ poster presentation must be E-mailed to : tropaconupukchaptertmu2019@gmail.com
- One should be annual/life member of IATP to present oral paper/poster in the conference for Award/ Free Category. Candidates interested for paper/ poster presentation, along with registration should apply for membership simultaneously. Membership Number will be provided through email.
- Post graduate students must attach a student certificate forwarded by their Head of Department.
- Abstracts will be reviewed by scientific committee prior to acceptance. When submitting an abstract, the presenting author may request for either Oral or Poster presentation.
- For oral presentation, participants are requested to bring presentation (PPT format) on Pen drive & E mail.
- Poster presenters will bring their printed poster with size 24 inches×36 inches along with sticking materials and pins.

Prizes will be awarded for best oral and poster presentation.
