# CALL FOR NOMINATIONS/APPLICATIONS FOR THE IATP AWARDS AND FELLOWSHIPS 2023, IN PARASITOLOGY

The Indian Academy of Tropical Parasitology (IATP) since its inception has remained committed to academic excellence and nurturing of research in parasitic diseases. To broaden the perspectives, the IATP, every year offers various awards and recognitions to its members as well as other Parasitologists of eminence in India and abroad for their contributions in the field of Parasitology.

## **1. Springer-Parija South East Asia Award of the IATP:**

This is a prestigious international award by the Springer with the Indian Academy of Tropical Parasitology (IATP) to be given every year. This award will be given for Excellence in research in parasitic diseases related to "One Health" to be awarded to the scientists from WHO South East Asian Member Countries (India, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Indonesia, Maldives, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Thailand, and Timor-Leste). It will be awarded to a mid-level scientist/faculty of 45-55 years age from any of these countries based on his/her publications in indexed journals. One person can get the award only once and the value of the award is in the form of Springer book Voucher of 2500 Euros. The awardee

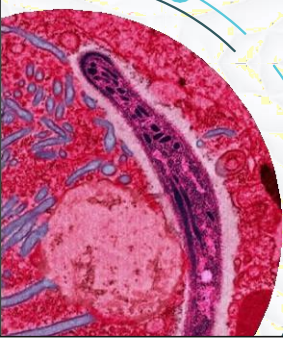
will be given a certificate and a gold medal at the Annual Congress of the Indian Academy of Tropical Parasitology 2023. Recipient will deliver an Oration during the Annual Congress.

## **2. Dr S.C. Parija Oration Award of the IATP:**

This is a prestigious international award of the Indian Academy of Tropical Parasitology (IATP) given every year to eminent parasitologist of age 55 years and above from India and abroad in recognition of their contributions to the field of parasitology. The person must be of repute in the field of parasitology and should have contributed immensely to the subject over a considerable period as evidenced by papers published in peer reviewed journals, monographs/ textbooks written on parasitological topics etc. In addition, individuals from the industry segment who have contributed to the development of parasitology would also be considered for the award. The awardee will be given a certificate and a gold medal at the Annual Congress of the Indian Academy of Tropical Parasitology. Recipient will deliver an Oration during the Annual Congress. Full transcript of the Oration will be published in the January-July 2024 issue of 'Tropical Parasitology', the official journal of IATP.

## **3. Fellow of the IATP:**

This is an important Fellowship given every





year to an eminent parasitologist of age 55 years and above from India and abroad in recognition of their contributions to the field of parasitology. The person must be of repute in the field of parasitology and should have contributed immensely to the subject. In addition, individuals from the industry segment who have contributed to the development of parasitology would also be considered for the award. The awardee will be given a certificate and a gold medal at the Annual Congress of the Indian Academy of Tropical Parasitology.

#### **4. Springer Award for the Best Oral Paper Presentation of the IATP:**

TROPACON is the national conference of IATP held every year during September-October at various locations in India. Till now, 16 such Conferences have been successfully held. In the Springer-IATP award, four best presentations will be selected by the judges and will be awarded as follows every year:

- a. Two Best Oral Paper Presentations by the Faculty or Scientist: Book vouchers of 500 Euros each to buy any book published by Springer International.
- b. Two Best Papers by Post graduate students (MD, MSc, PhD): Book vouchers of 250 Euros each to buy any book published

by Springer International.

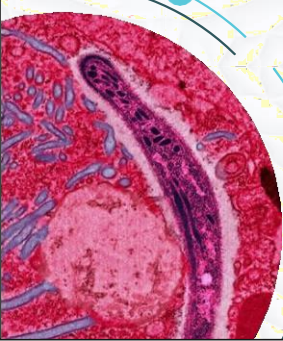
The members of the Indian Academy of Tropical Parasitology only are eligible for this Award

#### **5. Springer Award for Best Publication in Tropical Parasitology:**

The IATP has its own official journal Tropical Parasitology which is a biannual publication which is Scopus and PubMed indexed. For selecting the best papers, the previous year's publications will be judged by a panel of experts (with no conflict of interest) and awards will be given as: a. Maximum Three Best Original Articles: Book vouchers of 500 Euros each. b. Maximum Two Best Dispatches: Book vouchers of 250 Euro each.

A soft copy of the Self application/ Nomination including a covering letter with justification of the nomination and bio data indicating contribution in the field of parasitology, may be sent to the Prof Sumeeta Khurana, Secretary, IATP Awards and Orations Committee, the Indian Academy of Tropical Parasitology on or before 31st August 2023. # Guidelines for Oral and Poster Presentation:

1. All the abstracts submitted must be written in **English**.
2. The topic should be relevant to Parasitology.
3. Abstract should not be longer than **250 words** and must be written under following headings: **Background, Objective, Methodology, Results and Conclusion**.
4. **For Case reports:** Introduction, Case Management and Conclusion
5. Do not include Pictures, Tables and Charts within the abstract.
6. All abstracts submitted for Oral/Poster presentation will first be reviewed before acceptance.
7. The abstracts for Oral/Poster presentation must be sent as a **soft copy (Word/PDF)** to the Email ID: **tropacon2023@gmail.com**
8. For Award category Abstract submission kindly go through the guidelines as per the brochure and mail the abstract to **khuranasumeeta@gmail.com**
9. Confirmation regarding acceptance for Oral/Poster presentation will be communicated via Email.
10. Posters must be printed on 3' X 4' size paper only in **Portrait** layout. Any other size posters will not be allowed.
11. Oral presentation must be prepared on a **MS PowerPoint** presentation format containing not more than 15 slides.
12. Registration is mandatory for abstract submission.
13. Last Date for Abstract Submission is **30th September 2023**.

## Guidelines for Quiz participation:

1. Each team will have Two members either UG and/or PG and/or SR in any combinations.
2. Team members should be from the same Institution/College.
3. Pre-registration for the conference is not mandatory for preliminary round. While registration is mandatory for both the participants once selected for stage round.

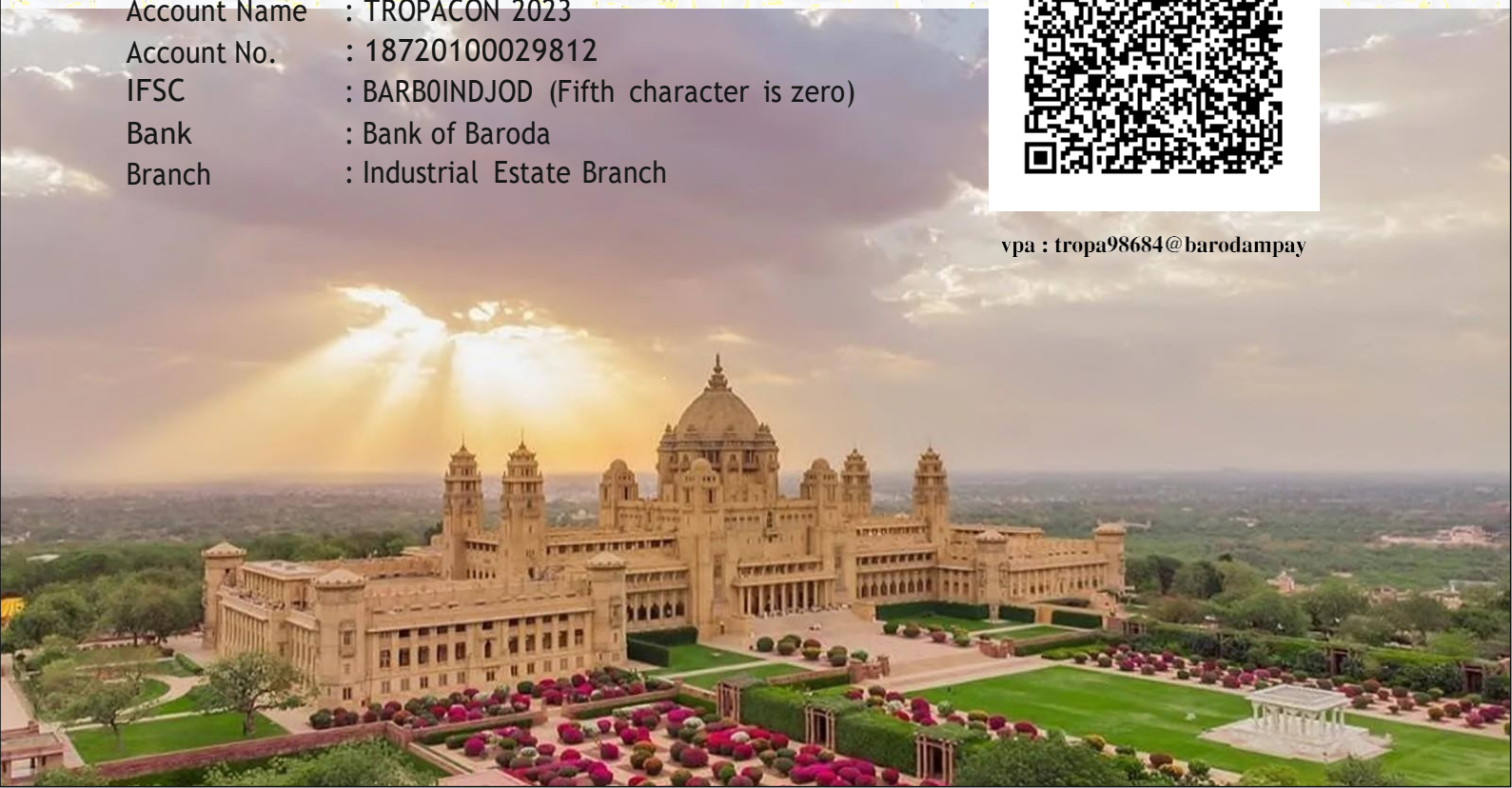
