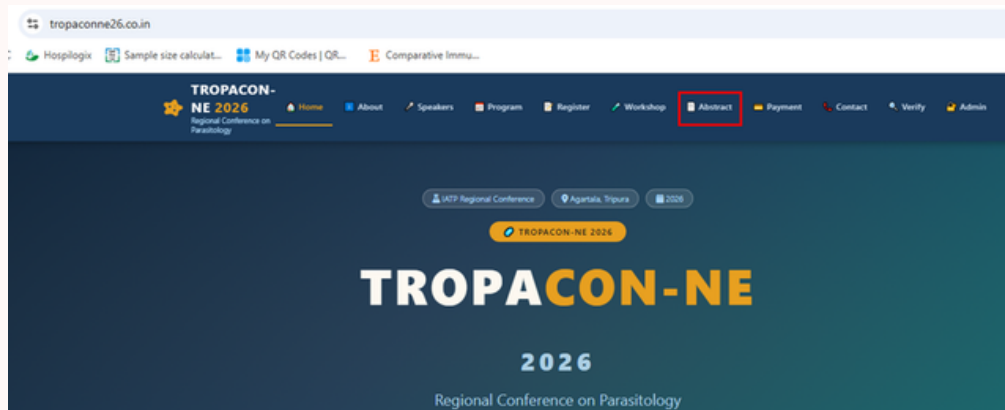

## Places to visit



### *Ujjayanta Palace, Agartala*

Ujjayanta Palace, the iconic landmark of Agartala, stands as a symbol of Tripura's royal heritage and architectural elegance. Built in 1901 by Maharaja Radha Kishore Manikya, it blends Mughal, European, and classical styles. Surrounded by lush gardens and serene water bodies, the palace now houses a state museum showcasing the rich culture and history of Northeast India. It offers visitors a glimpse into the grandeur of Tripura's regal past.

### *Tripurasundari Temple, Udaipur*

Tripura Sundari (Matabari) Temple, located in Udaipur, is one of the 51 revered Shakti Peethas in India, drawing pilgrims from across the country. Dedicated to Goddess Tripura Sundari, the temple is an important spiritual and cultural landmark of Tripura. Its distinctive square structure and the sacred Kalyan Sagar lake enhance its serene ambiance. The temple beautifully reflects the deep-rooted traditions and devotion of the region.



### *Neermahal, Melaghar*

Neermahal, the stunning water palace of Tripura, is nestled in the middle of Rudrasagar Lake near Melaghar. Built by Maharaja Bir Bikram Kishore Manikya in 1930, it beautifully blends Hindu and Mughal architectural styles. Surrounded by tranquil waters, the palace offers breathtaking views, especially at sunset. It stands as a unique symbol of Tripura's royal legacy and scenic charm.



### *Unakoti, Kailashahar*

Unakoti, a remarkable archaeological and pilgrimage site in Tripura, is famed for its massive rock-cut sculptures and bas-reliefs carved into forested hills. Believed to date back to the 7th–9th centuries, it features towering images of Lord Shiva and other deities. The name “Unakoti” means “one less than a crore,” rooted in local legend. This unique site beautifully blends history, mythology, and natural beauty.
